Please make sure your child comes to school with an outer layer as we have to have the windows open for ventilation.



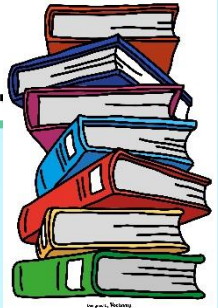
There's lots of outdoor learning this term so please bring sun hats and apply sun cream before school on warm days.
