Governors Behavior Principles

Sketchley Hill Primary School's board of governors will publish and review at least annually this statement of Governors Behaviour Principles. This will provide clear advice and guidance to the Head teacher on which they can base the school behaviour policy.

As a governing body, we will ensure that the Headteacher is aware of their obligations and powers under Section 88(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 (EIA). Notably to ensure that policies are designed to promote good behaviour and discipline on the part of its pupils and should be pursued at all times at our school.

Our principles are:

- The School will publish its Whole School Behaviour Policy which will ensure measures to promote good behaviour and respect, and prevent all forms of bullying while maintaining all legal and statutory guidelines.
- The School Governing Body will review and approve the Whole School Behaviour Policy and monitor its effectiveness throughout the school year.
- Every member of the school has a right to feel safe at all times.
- All staff, volunteers and governors will set an excellent example of positive behaviour to all pupils at all times.
- The school will actively promote inclusivity and equality, protecting and promoting the value of every pupil, staff member and volunteer.
- The School will reward good behaviour and maintain a positive learning environment through clear and consistent rules applied fairly.
- Where inappropriate or unacceptable behaviour is observed an appropriate level of sanction will be applied as detailed in the Whole School Behaviour Policy.
