At the end of the academic year 2021-2022, there were 9 FSM pupils in Year 2 and 6 FSM pupils in Year 6. There were 2 LAC pupils in Year 2 and 0 LAC pupils in Year 6. The table below shows the percentage of pupils working AT the expected standard.

Summary

- In Year 2, 2 pupils achieved the expected standard in all three subjects
- In Year 6, 5 out of 6 pupils achieved the expected standard in all three subjects
- 4 out of 6 pupils achieved GDS in reading and 1 out of 6 achieved GDS in Maths
- A lot of positive support to develop the emotional health and wellbeing in all year groups took place which benefited all disadvantaged pupils – this involved small group nurture, ELSA activities and Counselling.
- The support given to our disadvantaged pupils at break times and lunchtimes to develop social and relationship skills was a positive success giving the pupils the skills needed to resolve issues ready for High School.
