### Summary

- In Year 6, 5 out of 8 pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading
- In Year 6, 3 out of 8 pupils achieved the expected standard in Writing
- In Year 6, 4 out of 8 pupils achieved the expected standard in Maths
- 2 out of 8 disadvantaged children achieved GDS in Reading
- In Year 6, both of our LAC achieved in all subjects
- A lot of positive support to develop the emotional health and wellbeing in all year groups took place which benefited all disadvantaged pupils – this involved small group nurture, ELSA activities and Counselling.
- The support given to our disadvantaged pupils at break times and lunchtimes to develop social and relationship skills was a positive success giving the pupils the skills needed to resolve issues ready for High School.
