Reading

Children should be reading regularly (at least 5 times per week for a team token) and their reading homework sheets should be signed and where possible commented on by an adult. Every day your child will read as part of their phonics lessons and during their Guided Read session. Children will also receive a library book to share with an adult at home. Please ensure this is brought into school daily so that your child is able to change it, the day for this will vary.
