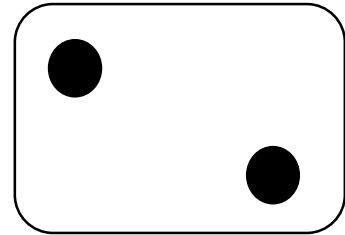
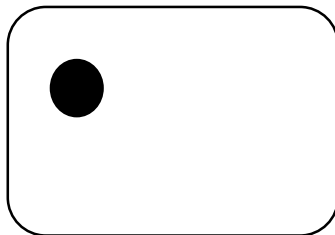
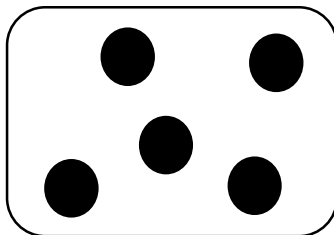
Now try splitting a collection into smaller equal groups. How many different equal groups can you split your collection into?

- c) 10 groups of 1.
- d) 7 groups of 2.
