Stone Age	The first known period of prehistoric human culture characterized by the use of stone tools.
Timeline	A table listing important events for successive years within a particular historical period.
Archaeology	The scientific study of material remains (such as tools, pottery, jewelry, stone walls, and monuments) of past human life and activities.
Settlement	A small village where people lived in tribes.
Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic	The three periods of the Stone age
Stonehenge	Stones erected by prehistoric people at Salisbury Plain, Southern England
Hunter gatherer	People who found food through hunting animals and fish

Fronted Adverbials

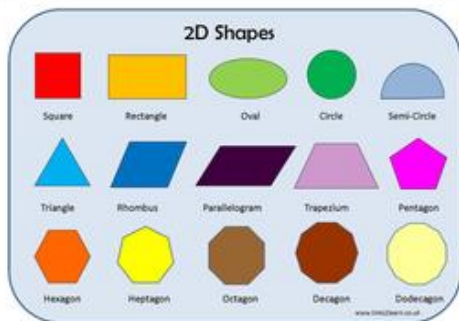
Words/phrases that are placed at the beginning of sentences

FREQUENCY: Daily, Sometimes, Once, Rarely, Regularly, Occasionally

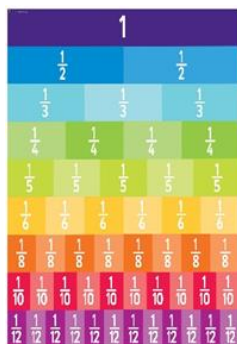
PLACE: Above the cloud, Below the sea, Under the ground, Behind the shed, In the box, Next to the river, In front of the fire

Carvings	Created on a rock surface by scouring, scratching, engraving, chiselling, carving or any similar method.
Stone Age Pot	Clay pots were used for storing and cooking food
Stone Age Tools	Arrows, spears, axes were made using flint (stone)
Investigate, Design, Plan, Make, Evaluate	Design and technology sequence used - explore existing ideas, draw/sketch own, plan materials/steps needed, make object, evaluate successes
