


Year 3 Autumn Term 1

Hot dinner orders will be made on the School Gateway.




Extracurricular activities

Curriculum Information

English

In English, we will cover reading, writing and spelling across a range of genres, including story-writing, recounts, poetry and non-fiction texts. Spelling, grammar and whole class reading lessons will also take place throughout the week. The weekly spelling test will take place on a Monday.



<u>Maths</u>

Maths lessons will involve place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. There is a weekly Times Tables Test on a Tuesday. In the Autumn term, we will initially be focusing on the 2x, 5x, 10x, 3x and 4x tables. Once the children know these, they will move onto the remaining times tables.



Curiosity Curriculum

In the Autumn term, our Curiosity Curriculum themes are <u>What is the Earth made</u> <u>of?</u> and <u>How powerful is our planet?</u>

The first topic **What is the Earth made of?** will encompass geography themes, including maps, rocks, rainforests and rivers. As part of the theme, we will investigate different trees in our local area.

The second topic <u>How powerful is our planet?</u> builds on the previous topic by introducing volcanoes, earthquakes and other forces at work on our planet.

Children can do their own research at home if they like and bring it in to share with the class.
