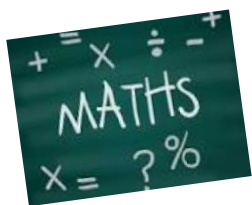

## **Curriculum Information**



### **Topic**

Our Curiosity Curriculum this term will involve two themes: '**Who invaded Britain?**' and '**What is Light?**'

In our **Who invaded Britain?** project, we will look at The Roman Empire, its invasion of Britain and the Celts rebellion. We are having a Roman day, delivered by Roman experts.

- In our **What is Light?** project, we will learn about how light is reflected from surfaces and how shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object
