### Writing formats

### Newspaper Reports

Reporter's name and job title eg. Alpha Smith, Media correspondent, Sheffield.

The main body should contain facts and not your own opinions. Information given should be chronological.

The last paragraph should sum up and bring the story up to date eg 'police are still investigating'

Use alliteration or word play to make it catchy if you want.

REMEMBER to write in third person!

An introductory paragraph. This should briefly sum up what the story is about. Think: Who? When? Where? How?

Have quotes and sources of the quotes to make your story credible. Use ... marks!
