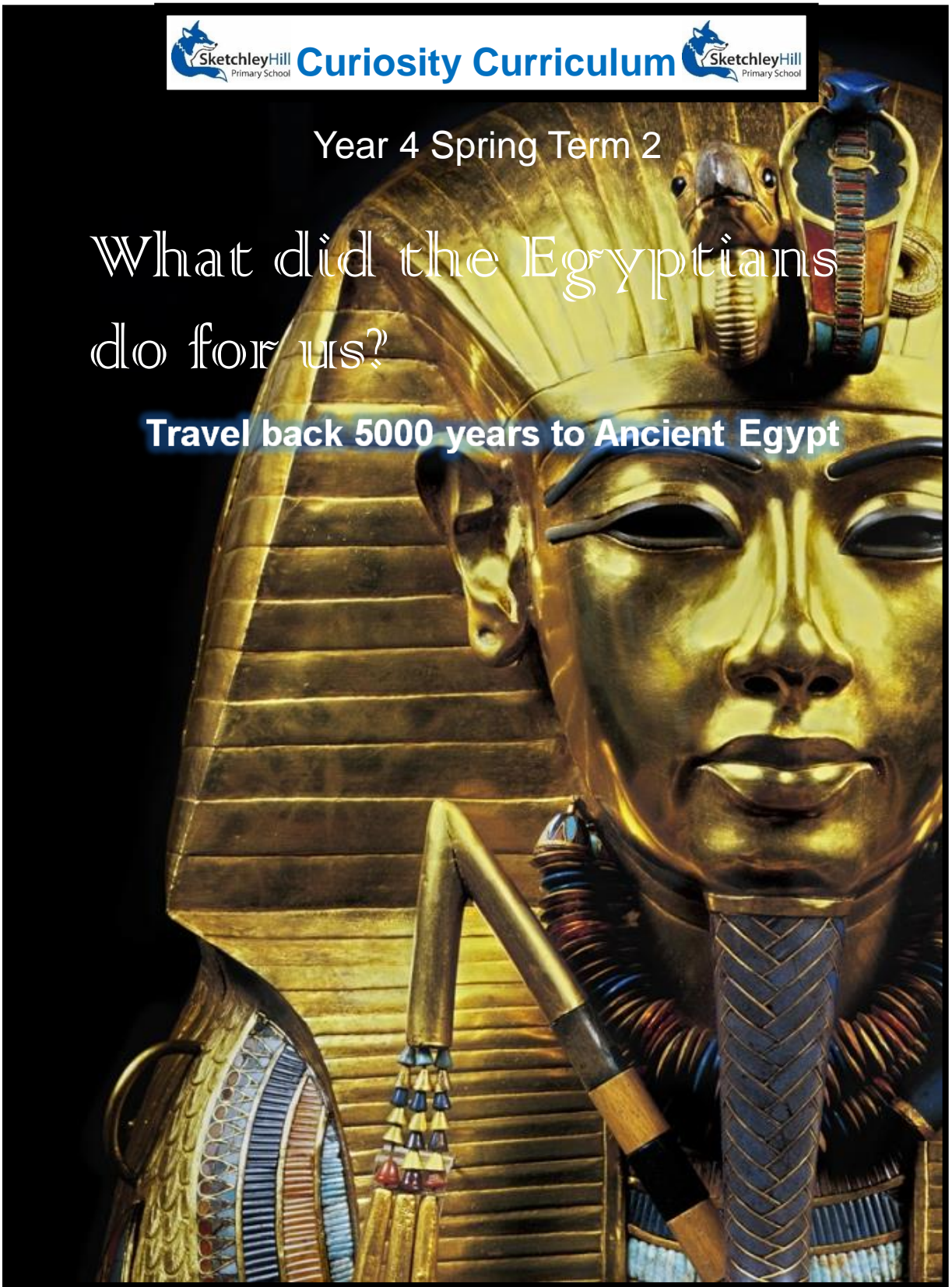

PE will continue on a Tuesday and a Thursday. On these days, your child can attend school in their PE kit.

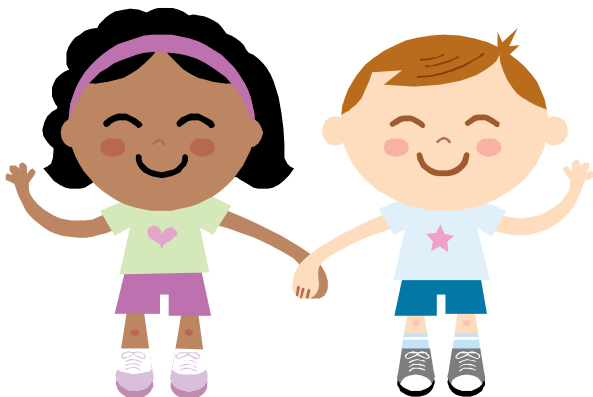
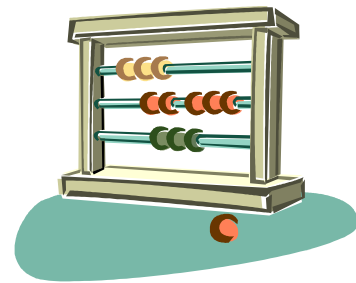


## Homework Reminders

Due to the Multiplication Tables Check, we encourage children to practice at every opportunity.
