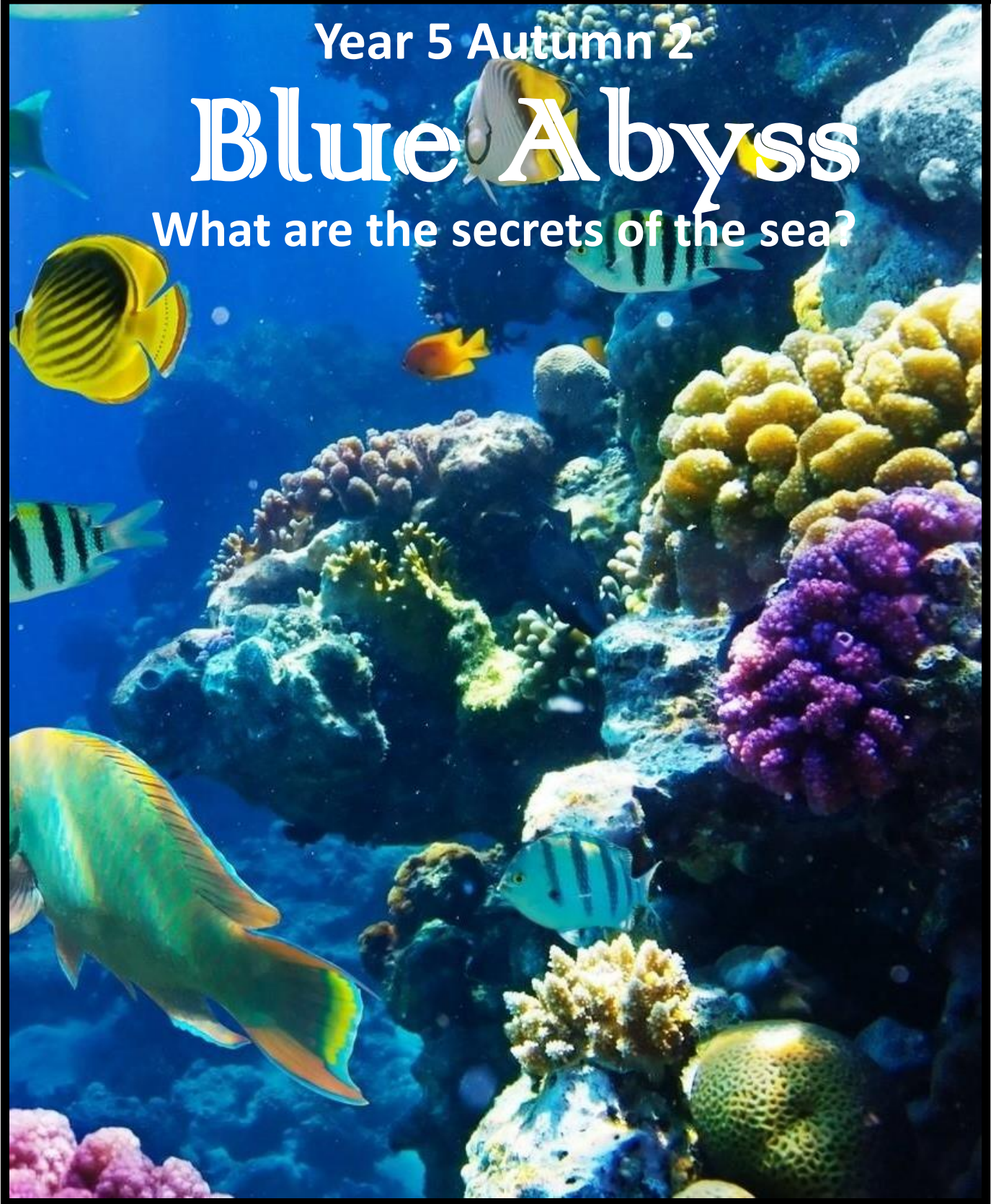

P.E.

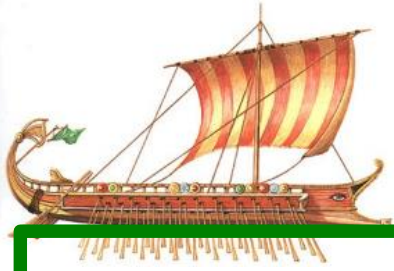
