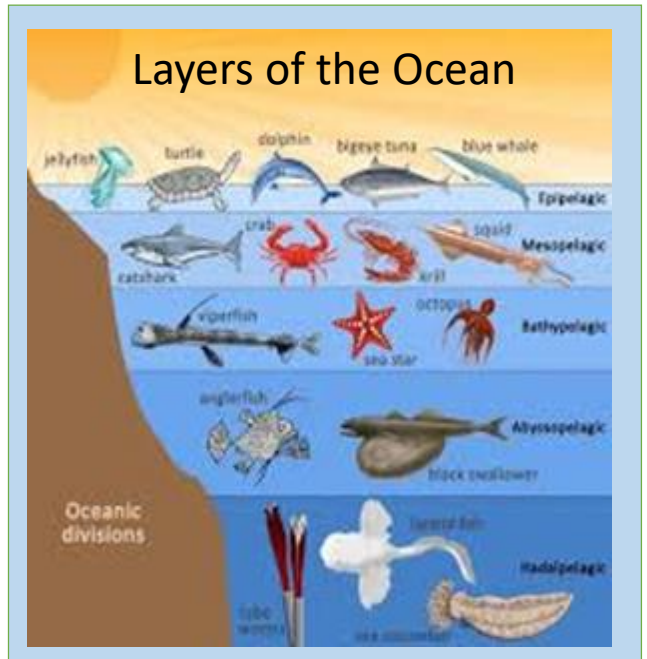

Submersible	a small submersible boat or other craft, designed for research and exploration.
Reef	a bar of rock, sand, coral or similar material, lying beneath the surface of water
Tide	the rise and fall of sea levels
Kelp	large brown algae seaweeds
Plankton	diverse collection of organisms that live in large bodies of water

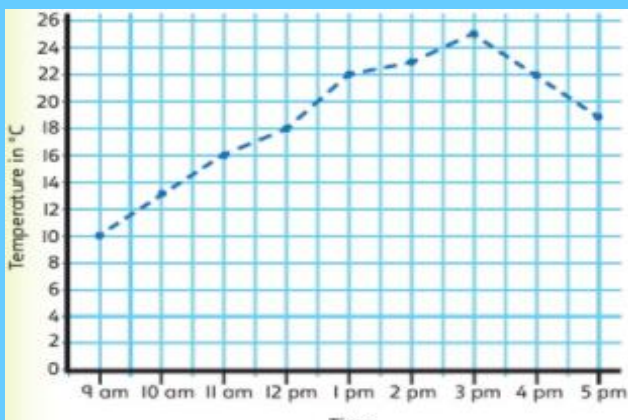
