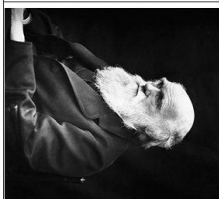
Famous Victorians

A famous engineer who designed bridges, tunnels and steam ships.



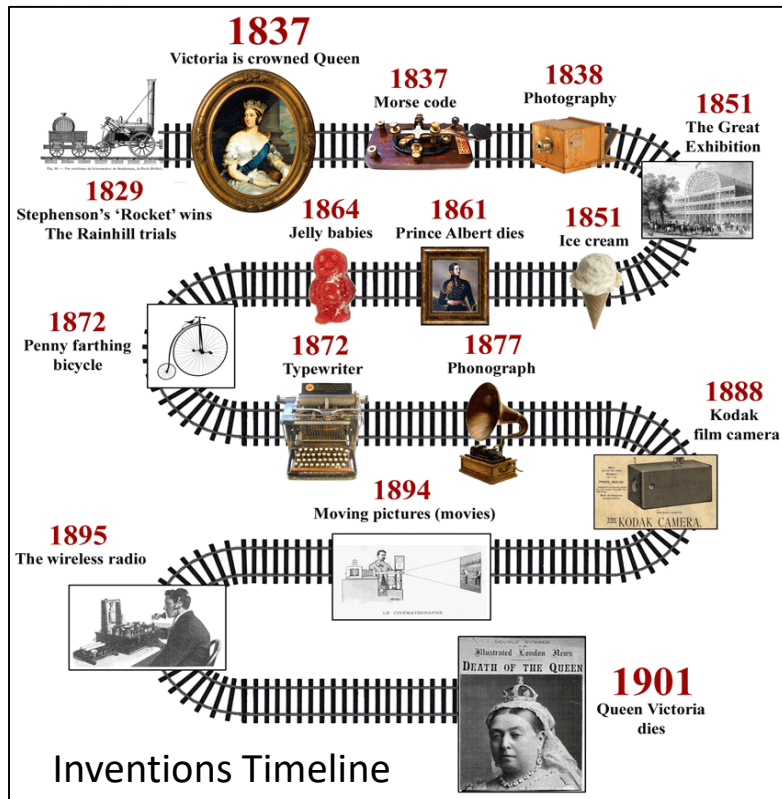
Elizabeth Garrett Anderson
