
# History – What was it like to be a soldier in WW1?

#### **Autobiographies**

- Similar to biographies in style
- Written in the first person

#### Stories with a flashback

- Flashbacks are descriptions of memories
- Flashbacks have a trigger e.g. a sound, smell, image etc.
- Characters and settings could be different in the flashback
- Verb tenses can vary


