

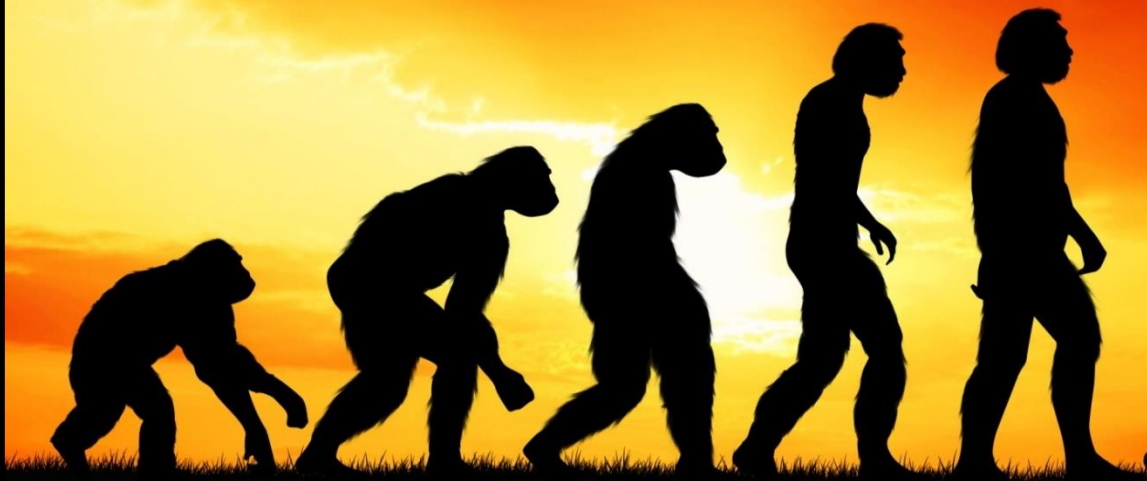

## Reading

Children should be reading regularly (**at least 5 times per week**) and their reading record books should be signed weekly by an adult. Signed reading record books must be handed in each Monday morning.



## Homework

### Maths:

Given out on a Friday, due in on a Monday (usually activities from CGP book which we look at together in class).

### English:

Given out on a Tuesday, due in on a Thursday (usually from CGP Punctuation book).

### Spelling:

Words and a rule are given out on a Monday and tested on the following Monday.



## P.E. & Games

Our P.E. slot is usually on a Tuesday and Friday afternoon. Pupils will continue to come into school in suitable kit ready for their lesson during the day. **All P.E. requires footwear that is appropriate for the time of year i.e. for use on the field.** Also, as the weather becomes colder it is best to have something warm to wear.
