

Reading

Children should be reading regularly (at least 5 times per week) and their reading record books should be signed / initialled by an adult. Signed reading record books must be handed in each morning.



Homework

Maths:

Given out on a Friday, due in on a Monday (usually activities from CGP book which we look at together in class).

English:

Given out on a Tuesday, due in on a Thursday (usually from CGP Punctuation book).

Spelling:

Words and a rule are given out on a Monday and tested on the following Monday.





P.E. & Games

Our P.E. slot is usually on a Tuesday and Friday afternoon. Pupils will continue to come into school in suitable kit ready for their lesson during the day. All P.E. requires footwear that is appropriate for the time of year i.e. for use on the field. Also, as the weather becomes colder it is best to have something warm to wear.
