

Reading

Given out on a Tuesday, due in on a Thursday (usually from CGP Punctuation book).

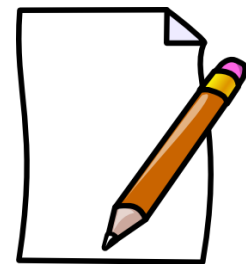
Spelling:
