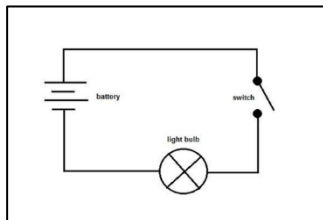
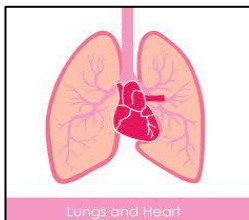

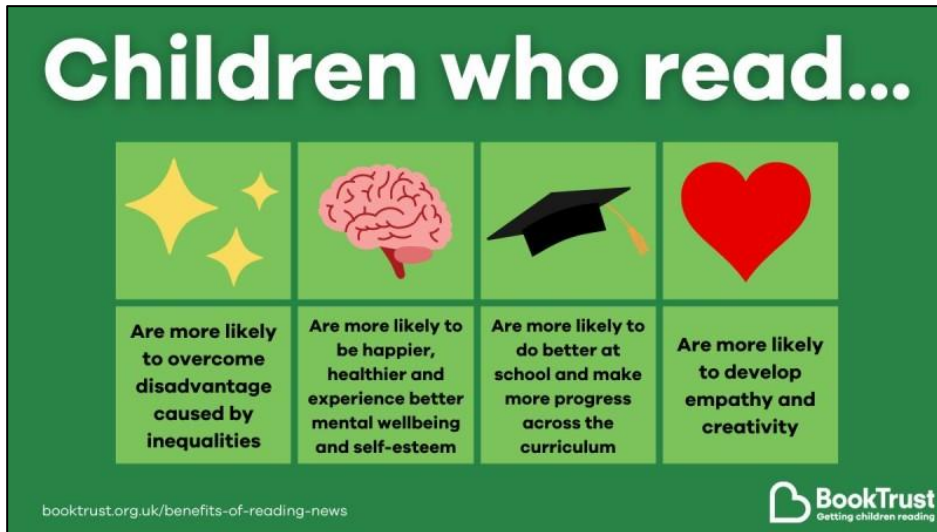

Reading

Children should be reading every week day at the very least and their reading record books should be signed / initialled by an adult. Record books are checked every morning and rewards are given for completion. Catch-up time will be allocated at break times to enable regular reading habits.



Homework

Maths:

Given out on a Friday, due in on a Monday (usually activities from CGP book which we look at together in class).

English:

Given out on a Tuesday, due in on a Thursday (usually from CGP Punctuation book).

Spelling:

Words and a rule are given out on a Monday and tested on the following Monday.

P.E.

Our P.E. slot is usually on a Wednesday and Thursday. Pupils will continue to come into school in suitable kit ready for their lesson during the day. All P.E. requires footwear that is appropriate for the time of year i.e. for use outside. Also, as the weather is colder it is best to have something warm to wear.
